## Project Brief

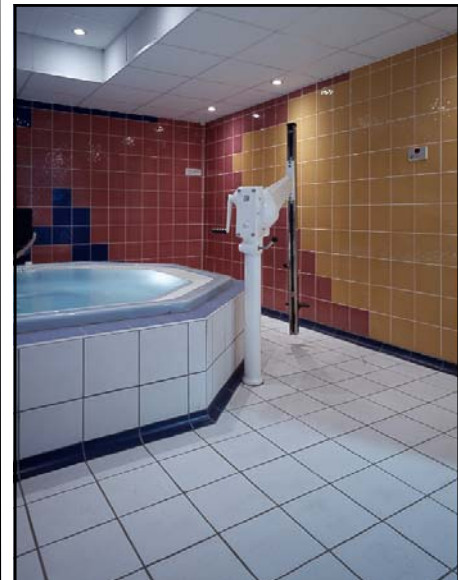
The Keech Cottage Hospice in Luton has an array of facilities available for visiting and long term patients including a swimming pool block featuring a 14m by 7m pool with underwater lighting and sound systems, a whirlpool bath, changing and toilet facilities, with a viewing gallery overlooking the main pool.



## Solution

**Weber** were asked to specify appropriate adhesives and grouts from the tiling portfolio range to accommodate the tiling requirements of the impressive swimming pool and adjoining changing rooms. **stoneset flexible SP rapidset adhesive** was specified in conjunction with **weber.joint wide** in grey for the fixing of the floor tiles. **stoneset flexible SP rapidset adhesive** is a cement based polymer-modified tile adhesive suitable for fixing all types of natural stones, ceramic wall and floor tiles, mosaics, terrazzo, brick slips and glass blocks in areas that will be dry or wet. Available in a range of colours, the **weber.joint wide** in grey finished off the floor area.

**weber.fix WR plus** was specified for the fitting of the wall tiles; a high performance, ready-mixed ceramic wall tile adhesive ideal for areas where increased resistance to water is required. **weber.joint wide** in white was chosen to finish the walls. Tiled by A G Ceramics of Stevenage, the pool has been carefully designed to cater for the needs of disabled and frail patients of all ages.
